

Article 14

“The domicile is inviolable.

There must not be inspections or searches or kidnappings except for the cases and ways prescribed by the law and in accordance with the guarantees prescribed for the personal freedom safeguard.

The investigations and inspections, for health reasons, public safety or economic purposes and tax, are regulated by special laws.”

The word domicile defines the place where a person lives and works, without the intervention of the outsiders. It refers both to the house, the place where a person lives permanently, and to the place of work, where a person has the principal seat of business.

This concept includes the word “abode” too, the place where a person is temporarily (ex. Holidays home, hotel, hospital).The domicile is inviolable. Anyone can hamper that other people introduce themselves in their domicile against their will. You can't spread videos or pictures.

Inspections, searches or seizures at home can take place according to the law and only under a judge's ruling.

It's possible instead, even without an order of the judge, to carry out checks or inspections of a domicile, for health's reasons, (checking of the hygienic conditions of the job place), safety (checking of the respect of the forces of the security of work from the employer) or for commercial and fiscal purposes (checking of the respect of the tributaries forces). In these cases, regulated by special laws, there isn't an inviolability of the domicile.
