

Article 15 Cost.

“Freedom and confidentiality of letters and of any other forms of communication are inviolable.

Their limit might be possible only with an act motivated by the judicial authority within the guarantees established by the law.”

Everyone is free to express and communicate his thought to whom he wants and to choose to keep their communication secret (i.e. between sender and consignee). This article deals with the correspondence considered as sealed letter, but it extends it to every other type of communication, i.e. by telephone, computer or other technological devices. Freedom and secrecy are the expressions of the right to secrecy. The appointed of this right are citizens, foreigners, physical persons, juridical persons and social subjects.
