

Article 16

All citizens may travel or sojourn freely in any part of the national territory, except for general limitations which the law establishes for reasons of health and security. No restrictions may be made for political reasons.

All citizens are free to leave and re-enter the territory of the Republic, provided all legal obligations are fulfilled.

Every citizen can move on the Italian territory, except for security reasons, for example areas where they occurred earthquakes, or for health reasons, as areas where they occur of epidemics. From a political point of view, the freedom of movement can't be limited, as it happened during the fascist period. In that time opponents were sent in confinement, or rather isolated to avoid the diffusion of their idea and so influence other people and generate riots. All citizens have got the possibility to enter or exit from Italy except for some limitation of the law, as family obligations, of justice, military or to have a passport.
